**Note 1**

GIRFT has shown that these patients often wait several days before a slot in the emergency theatre is available. Trusts should ensure that slots are available either speciality trauma lists, speciality carve out time on general (CEPOD) emergency lists or carve out on speciality elective lists. **Note 2**

Patients seen for speciality trauma assessment should be booked to a planned theatre slot. This ideally should be a day case list

**Note 3**

The majority of patients once treated for a fractured mandible should be ready to go home on day of surgery. Data shows that patients treated in a planned way (2 above) can be managed with no overnight stay, some units achieving 80% day stay.
